2010 - 2011 FINANCIAL AID CHECKLIST

- 1. Apply for admission to JCJC.**
All applicants must meet admission requirements to receive financial assistance. (*Students must be admitted and currently enrolled in a degree-granting or certificate program.*)
- 2. Apply for the 2010 - 2011 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). PLEASE READ ALL STEPS BEFORE APPLYING ONLINE.**
Step 1 -
If you do not have a FAFSA on the Web Pre-Application Worksheet, download and print the worksheet at www.fafsa.gov .
Step 2 -
Complete the worksheet based on 2009 tax documents.
Step 3 -
Apply for a Personal Identification Number (PIN) at www.pin.ed.gov . The PIN can be used for subsequent school years.
All students must obtain a PIN. In addition, if the student does not check a box in Section 2 on the pre-application worksheet, one parent must also obtain a PIN.
Three options to receive PIN:
 1. **Create PIN** (*instantaneously*)
 2. **E-mail** (*up to 2 days*)
Print the email when opening the document the first time.
 3. **U.S. Mail** (*7 to 10 days*)**Step 4 -**
Complete the online FAFSA application at www.fafsa.gov . Include JCJC's school code - 002411.
- 3. Waiting period.**
The federal processor sends results to JCJC if the school code is listed on the FAFSA. A Student Aid Report (SAR) is also emailed to the student within 2 days (*if applied online*). However, if the student completed and mailed a paper application, allow 4-6 weeks to receive the SAR. Review the SAR for accuracy and be sure JCJC is listed as a college to receive your information. (*If a SAR is not received within six weeks, contact the Central Processing System at 1-800-433-3243.*)
- 4. Respond promptly to the JCJC Financial Aid Office (FAO).**
If additional information is needed, the student will receive a letter from the FAO indicating the item(s) needed. Submit the requested information as soon as possible. (*The priority date for Fall 2010/Spring 2011 financial aid paperwork is May 3, 2010. Paperwork received after the priority date may not be completed by the beginning of the Fall semester.*)
- 5. Check/View financial aid status.**
Students can log in the JCPortal to view current financial aid status. (*Step 1 must be completed to check financial aid status. Other grants and scholarships can also be viewed.*)
- 6. To determine if a file is complete.**
An award notification letter stating the type of aid and amount awarded will be mailed to the student.
- 7. Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP).** Students receiving any form of financial aid from JCJC will be expected to maintain satisfactory academic progress toward their degree objective.

FAFSA worksheets are available at JCJC.
